- Being prepared to financially reimburse the choir for lost musical scores or uniform if I cannot return it

- Supporting the choirs aims and values, their Code of Practise and all other policies (which I have reviewed on the website)
- Taking an interest in my child's life with the choir and encouraging them to practise at home and attend as many rehearsals and performances as possible
- Behaving politely and courteously to all choir members, its committee and its adult leaders
